

EDUCATION, LICENSING AND REGISTRATION COMMITTEE

Mandate: Three (03) years renewable once

Functions:

1. Processes applications for registration of medical and dental practitioners;
2. Process applications for license to render medical and dental services for newly qualified doctors;
3. Coordinate assessment and Internship Qualifying examinations for foreign trained doctors/dental surgeons;
4. Monitors implementation of internship training programmes;
5. Participate in the new internship training centres accreditation;
6. Review postgraduate qualifications for inclusion on the list of approved specialist qualifications;
7. Process applications for specialist recognition;
8. Review curriculae for medical and dental training;
9. Take part in the University medical and dental examinations;
10. Participate in the joint inspections of medical and dental schools;
11. Review the Policy and Strategic Plan of the Continuing Professional Development (CPD);
12. Assist in CPD needs assessment and evaluation;
13. Participate in long- and short-term planning of CPD;
14. Take disciplinary measures to those who do not comply with council's regulations;
15. To promote and encourage all initiatives aimed at improving the health of the population;
16. To set up regulations on the minimum skills and qualifications that are required for each category of any medical practitioner;
17. Review and propose the registration and licensing fees;
18. Perform any other related educational and registration/licensing functions.

The Committee shall meet twice a month or any time when necessary called by its president.

Decisions of the committee are taken by consensus.
